Hanofee Park Summer Day Camp

Town of Liberty registration for the Summer Day Camp will begin April 4th from 6:00pm - 7:00pm for Residents in the Liberty Senior Center located upstairs from the Liberty Parks and Rec. offices. Regular office hours will apply for registration the following day. Non-Resident registration will begin May 3rd during regular office hours. Registration ends June 10th or before if camp fills. Camp is for children ages 5-13 and begins June 27th and ends August 12th. There are three sessions to choose from:
