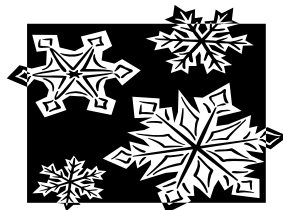

Pre Registration is required for all Rec. Programs.

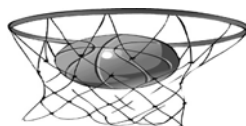
YOUTH PROGRAMS

Youth Basketball

The Town of Liberty Parks and Recreation and the Liberty Athletic Department will be running a Boys and Girls youth basketball Program.
