

## Chapter A151

### ELECTION DISTRICTS

**[HISTORY: Adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Liberty 7-10-1986. Amendments noted where applicable.]**

#### **§ A151-1. Designation of election districts and polling places.**

- A. Election District No. 1. Town Government Center, 120 North Main Street, Liberty, New York. All that portion of the Village and Town of Liberty, County of Sullivan and State of New York, bounded and described as follows: beginning at a point in the Village of Liberty at the intersection of Main Street and Chestnut Street (State Route 52); thence westerly along the center of State Route 52 to the center of Corrigan Road (Town Road No. 16); thence northerly along the center of Corrigan Road and the old road formerly known as "Chaffee Road" to the center of Elk Point Road (Town Road No. 27); thence easterly along the center of Elk Point Road to the center of Benton Hollow Road (Town Road No. 9); thence easterly along Benton Hollow Road to the center of Revonah Hill Road (Town Road No. 72); thence southerly and easterly along Revonah Hill Road and Buckley Street to the center of Lincoln Place; thence southerly along Lincoln Place to the center of St. Paul's Place; thence easterly along St. Paul's Place to the center of Academy Street; thence northerly along Academy Street to the center of Law Street; thence easterly along Law Street to the center of North Main Street; thence southerly along North Main Street to the place of beginning.
- B. Election District No. 2. Senior Citizen Center, 119 North Main Street, Liberty, New York. All that portion of the Village and Town of Liberty, County of Sullivan and State of New York, bounded and described as follows: beginning at a point in the Village of Liberty at the intersection of Main Street and Darbee Lane; thence northerly along the center of North Main Street and County Road 176 (Old State Route 17) to the center of Weiss Road (Town Road No. 63); thence easterly along Weiss Road and crossing State Route 17 (Quickway) to the center of Novaselsky Road (Town Road No. 64); thence easterly along Novaselsky Road to the center of Ahrens Road; thence northerly along Ahrens Road (Town Road No. 2) to the center of Tanzman Road (Town Road No. 7); thence westerly along Tanzman Road to the center of Budnick Road (Town Road No. 6); thence easterly along Budnick Road to the center of Muhlig Road (Town Road No. 45); thence easterly along Muhlig Road to the Neversink Town Line; thence easterly and southerly along the Neversink Town Line and southerly along the Fallsburg Town Line to the center of County Road No. 16 (Neversink Road); thence westerly along County Road No. 16 to the center of Muhlig Road; thence westerly and northerly along Muhlig Road to the center of Aden Road (Town Road No. 1); thence westerly along Aden Road to the center of Cold Spring Road (Town Road No. 11); thence westerly and southerly along Cold Spring Road to the center of Darbee Lane; thence westerly along the center of Darbee Lane to the place of beginning.
- C. Election District No. 3. Parksville Methodist Church, Parksville, New York. All that

portion of the Town of Liberty, County of Sullivan and State of New York, bounded and described as follows: beginning at a point at the intersection of County Road No. 176 (Old State Route 17) and Revonah Hill Road (Town Road No. 72); thence southerly along the center of Revonah Hill Road to the center of Benton Hollow Road (Town Road No. 9); thence westerly along Benton Hollow Road to the center of Elk Point Road (Town Road No. 27); thence southerly and westerly along Elk Point Road to the center of Fox Mountain Road (Town Road No. 62); thence northerly along Fox Mountain Road to the center of Golub Hill Road (Town Road No. 61); thence westerly along Golub Hill Road to the center of County Road No. 146; then northerly along County Road No. 146 to the Rockland Town Line; thence easterly, northerly and easterly along the Rockland Town Line to the westerly line of the Town of Neversink; thence southerly and easterly along the Neversink Town line to the center of Muhlig Road (Town Road No. 45); thence westerly along Muhlig Road to the center of Budnick Road (Town Road No. 6); thence westerly along Budnick Road to the center of Tanzman Road (Town Road No. 7); thence easterly along Tanzman Road to the center of Ahrens Road (Town Road No. 2); thence southerly along Ahrens Road to the center of Novaselsky Road (Town Road No. 64); thence westerly along Novaselsky Road crossing State Route 17 (Quickway) to the center of Weiss Road (Town Road No. 63); thence westerly along Weiss Road to the center of County Road No. 176; thence northerly along County Road No. 176 to the place of beginning.

- D. Election District No. 4. White Sulphur Springs Fire House, White Sulphur Springs, New York. All that portion of the Town of Liberty, County of Sullivan and State of New York, bounded and described as follows: beginning at a point at the intersection of State Route 52 and Lake Marie Road (Town Road No. 84); thence southerly along Lake Marie Road to the center of the Lake Marie outlet brook; thence southerly along said outlet brook as it winds and turns to the northerly shore of Swan Lake; thence southerly across Swan Lake to a point at the intersection of County Road No. 142 and Somers Road (Town Road No. 82); thence southerly along Somers Road to the Bethel Town Line; thence westerly along the Bethel Town Line to the southeast corner of the Town of Callicoon; thence along the Callicoon Town Line northerly, easterly, northerly, westerly and northerly to a point in the south bounds of the Town of Rockland; thence easterly along the Rockland Town Line to a point in the center of County Road No. 146; thence southerly along County Road 146 to the center of Golub Hill Road (Town Road No. 61); thence easterly along Golub Hill Road to the center of Fox Mountain Road (Town Road No. 62); thence southerly along Fox Mountain Road to the center of Elk Point Road (Town Road No. 27); thence easterly along Elk Point Road to the center of the old road formerly known as "Chaffee Road"; thence southerly along Chaffee Road to the center of Corrigan Road (Town Road No. 16); thence southerly along Corrigan Road to the center of State Route 52; thence easterly along Route 52 to the place of beginning.
- E. Election District No. 5. Ambulance Corp. Building, 180 Mill Street, Liberty, New York. All that portion of the Village and Town of Liberty, County of Sullivan and State of New York, bounded and described as follows: beginning at a point at the intersection of South Main Street (State Route 52) in the Village of Liberty and Lake Street; thence southeasterly along Route 52 to the center of County Road No. 175 (Sullivan Avenue); thence southerly along County Road No. 175 to the center of County Road No. 71; thence southwesterly along County Road No. 71 to the center of Ferndale-Loomis Road (Town Road No. 3);

thence westerly along Ferndale-Loomis Road to the center of County Road No. 15; thence northerly along County Road No. 15 to the center of Lake Street; thence easterly along Lake Street to the place of beginning.

- F. Election District No. 6. Liberty Methodist Church, 170 North Main Street, Liberty, New York. All that portion of the Village and Town of Liberty, County of Sullivan and State of New York, bounded and described as follows: beginning at a point at the intersection of North Main Street and Law Street in the Village of Liberty; thence westerly along Law Street to the center of Academy Street; thence southerly along Academy Street to the center of St. Paul's Place; thence westerly along St. Paul's Place to the center of Lincoln Place; thence northerly along Lincoln Place to the center of Buckley Street; thence westerly along Buckley Street and northerly along Revonah Hill Road (Town Road No. 72) to the center of County Road No. 176; thence southerly along County Road No. 176 (Old State Route 17) and North Main Street to the place of beginning.
- G. Election District No. 7. Gerow-Ford Car Dealership, 127 Mill Street, Liberty, New York. All that portion of the Village and Town of Liberty, County of Sullivan and State of New York, bounded and described as follows: beginning at a point at the intersection of State Route 52 and Old State Route 17 and Darbee Lane in the Village of Liberty; thence easterly along the center of Darbee Lane to the center of Cold Spring Road (Town Road No. 11); thence northerly along Cold Spring Road to the center of Aden Road (Town Road No. 1); thence northeasterly along Aden Road to the center of Muhlig Road (Town Road No. 45); thence southerly and easterly along Muhlig Road to the center of County Road No. 16 (Neversink Road); thence easterly along County Road No. 16 to the Fallsburg Town Line; thence along the Fallsburg Town Line southerly, easterly and southerly to a point in the north line of the Town of Thompson; thence westerly along the Thompson Town Line to the center of County Road No. 72; thence northerly along County Road No. 72 and County Road No. 71 to the center of County Road No. 175; thence northerly along County Road No. 175 to the center of State Route 52; thence northwesterly along Route 52 and Mill Street and South Main Street in the Village of Liberty to the place of beginning.
- H. Election District No. 8. Lutheran Church, 26 Chestnut Street, Liberty, New York. All that portion of the Village and Town of Liberty, County of Sullivan and State of New York, bounded and described as follows: beginning at a point at the intersection of State Route 52 (Chestnut Street) and Old State Route 17 (Main Street) in the Village of Liberty; thence southerly along South Main Street to the center of Lake Street; thence westerly along Lake Street to the center of County Road No. 15; thence southerly along County Road No. 15 to the center of Ferndale-Loomis Road (Town Road No. 3); thence westerly along Ferndale-Loomis Road to the center of Kelly Bridge Road (Town Road No. 97); thence southerly along Kelly Bridge Road to the southerly shore of Swan Lake; thence westerly along the southerly shore of Swan Lake to a point at the intersection of County Road No. 142 and Somers Road (Town Road No. 82); thence northerly across Swan Lake to the Lake Marie outlet brook; thence northerly along the center of the Lake Marie outlet brook as it winds and turns to the center of Lake Marie Road (Town Road No. 84); thence northerly along Lake Marie Road to the center of State Route 52; thence easterly along Route 52 and Chestnut Street to the place of beginning.
- I. Election District No. 9. Swan Lake Fire House, Swan Lake, New York. All that portion of

the Town of Liberty, County of Sullivan and State of New York, bounded and described as follows: beginning at a point at the intersection of Ferndale-Loomis Road (Town Road No. 3) and Kelly Bridge Road (Town Road No. 97); thence easterly along Ferndale-Loomis Road to the center of County Road No. 71; thence southerly along County Road No. 71 to the center of County Road No. 72; thence southerly along County Road No. 72 (Lieutenant Brender Highway) to the Bethel Town Line; thence westerly along the Bethel Town Line to the center of Somers Road (Town Road No. 82); thence northerly along Somers Road to the southerly shore of Swan Lake on the northerly side of County Road No. 142; thence easterly along the southerly shore of Swan Lake to a point in the center of Kelly Bridge Road (Town Road No. 97); thence northerly along Kelly Bridge Road to the place of beginning.
