PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that there has been introduced before the Town Board of the Town of Liberty in the County of Sullivan and State of New York, introductory Local Law No. 1 of the Year 2014, entitled "A local law amending Article II, entitled 'Prohibited Parking,' of Chapter 139 of the Code of the Town of Liberty, Sullivan County, New York," which introductory law has been amended.

The proposed local law, as amended, prohibits stopping, standing and/or parking of vehicles on both sides of Old White Lake Turnpike (Town Road 83) from its intersection with Stanton Corner Road (County Road 74) to the Town of Bethel town line. The proposed local law, as amended, also establishes a fine schedule for parking offenses.

A copy of the aforesaid local law, as amended, is on file with the Town Clerk of the Town of Liberty, New York, where the same may be examined.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, pursuant to §20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, a public hearing will be held on the aforesaid local law, as amended, before the Town Board of the Town of Liberty, at the Town of Liberty Town Hall, 120 North Main Street, Liberty, New York, at 6:55 p.m. prevailing time, on August 18, 2014, at which time all interested persons will be heard.
