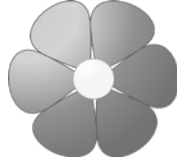

Hanofee Park Summer Day Camp

Town of Liberty Resident registration for the Summer Day Camp will begin April 4th from 6:00pm - 7:00pm for Residents in the Liberty Senior Center located upstairs from the Liberty Parks and Recreation offices. Registration will continue during regular office hours thereafter.

Non-Resident registration will begin May 2nd during regular office hours.

Camp is for children ages 5-13 and begins June 27th and ends August 12th. There are three sessions to choose from:

Full Day (8:00am - 5:00pm)	-	\$485 Residents,	\$595 Non-Residents
Morning (8:00am - 12:00pm)	-	\$335 Residents,	\$395 Non-Residents
Afternoon (12:00pm - 5:00pm)	-	\$360 Residents,	\$420 Non-Residents

MUST BRING PROOF OF RESIDENCY (Tax Bill, Utility Bill), COPY OF BIRTH CERTIFICATE, CURRENT IMMUNIZATION RECORDS, AND PAYMENT IN FULL WHEN REGISTERING.

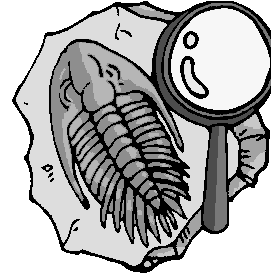
This is a wonderful opportunity to learn more about chess, board games and card games by playing with peers and an adult facilitator who will guide students through this exciting process!

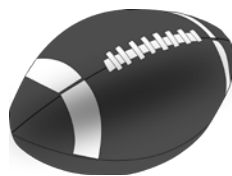
