I would like to thank Stacey Yaun, Frank DeMayo and the members of the board for the time spent answering my questions and concerns.

Regarding the building moratorium: Is it still in place or is it over and the policy is that the planning board has to get written approval from the water/sewer dept in order for someone to build?

From what I have been able to find out,. the EFC requires a specific amount requested attached to a specific plan and detailed budget. It is not possible to ask for \$10 to \$20 million and scale back from \$20 million after approval. Whatever amount is requested is the amount that must be spent. So that would mean that the town needs a very specific plan, which, as a novice, certainly makes more sense to me. I would think that Delaware Engineering has a plan to update the sewer plant and provide for a small amount of expansion. If you ask for \$20 million that is what you will have to spend, and as far as I am concerned, is not an option as both a taxpayer and a resident who wants to maintain the rural character of Swan Lake.
