According to numbers from Delaware Engineering, the sewer district upgrade is expected to raise annual sewer rates from \$840 to between \$1,536 and \$1,415. The town said it would try to mitigate costs by "aggressively pursuing" grants, including a potential \$4.5 million matching EFC grant. What do these increases mean for the us the taxpayer? We get very little services for living in Swan Lake. I cannot remember the last time our roads were properly paved. Doing the 20 million proposal is preparing for future developments which we have to pay for. I'd like to know how much each homeowner would have to pay, ball park figure.. I am on social security this is not fair to many of us who have no other income.. I'd like to see you get other proposals from different companies.
