

Do you know someone who has no internet or slow internet? They only have until April 11 to tell New York that they are not connected!

Please tell them about this program and ask them to take the following steps:

- 1. Members of the public can find their home or business on the draft map and submit a public comment by clicking here:
- 2. https://register.broadband.ny.gov/map-correction
- 3. Along with a comment, those without service will need to submit some documentation, such as speed tests or a formal denial of service from and internet provider, to finalize their comment.
- 4. Pattern for Progress or a local government will then turn that comment into a formal challenge to the map, making that community eligible for the federal funds.
